

U11 – U14 Fee Information

The registration fees due to Southside Soccer Club include most all of the costs associated with playing on a competitive soccer team. While many clubs do not structure their fees in this manner, we feel that by collecting the fees up front, there are fewer surprises during the season. The family will still need to purchase uniforms, pay for travel, tournaments not listed below, and team equipment, but, the majority of expenses are paid as part of the registration process. This fee system allows families to better budget their expenses throughout the soccer season.

The registration fee includes all of the following for the May through April season: Player, Coach and Team Fees; Chinook Cup entry fee; State Cup (or alternative) entry fee; Field Use Fees; Club Overhead; Field Equipment; Field Maintenance.

If you are trying out for a U14 team, the annual fee will include coaching through July 31st to help additionally prepare the incoming freshman player for high school soccer. Additional team fees may be required for player gear, additional tournament entry fees, team travel, team equipment (banner, corner flags, training gear, etc), coach reimbursements, indoor season entry fees and other team expenses that occur during the season.

The fee for the U11-U14 competitive year is \$1,360. This fee can be paid in full or you can take advantage of our installment plan. We offer a discount when there is more than one classic player from the same family on a Southside competitive team. Here is the full fee breakdown:

- The single player fee is \$1,360
- The multi-family member fee is \$1,260 per player

Installment Plan:

- If paying the single player fee of \$1,360, \$340 is due May 15th; \$340 due July 1st, September 1st and November 1st.
- If paying the multi family member fee of \$1,260, \$315 is due by May 15th; \$315 due July 1st, September 1st and November 1st for each player.

After you have made the initial payment, any discounts will come in the form of a refund or rebate.

If your player joins a team after June 1st, please contact the office for payment plan details.

They are also reimbursed for meals, lodging and rental car/airfare if those expenses are incurred.	\$25 – \$250
Manager Reimbursement: Some teams may reimburse the team manager for their airfare and lodging for out-of-state tournaments as they are there working and handling many important responsibilities for the team.	\$25 – \$250
