Financial Aid Application

Attached is the official financial aid application for Southside Soccer Club. Your application will be confidentially reviewed. Please fill in the form as indicated and return to our club address prior to tryouts or at the time of registration. The Director of Club Operations will communicate the level of aid your family will receive within two weeks AFTER the tryouts. All decisions are final.

The Southside Soccer Club is supported through the help of our volunteers and the ability of our families to pay the full cost of our programs. **As a recipient of financial assistance, we require that you volunteer a minimum of 50 hours during the twelve month season. We also require you and your family meet all requirements of the financial commitment you make when signing the form, for example monthly minimum payments.** Failure to perform your volunteer hours and lack of minimum payments will make you ineligible for financial assistance the following year and even immediate dismissal from your current team.

It is the intent of the club to give all qualified players the opportunity to play classic level soccer. Due to the nature of competitive soccer, families and players are expected to cover their own expenses. Southside Soccer Club provides a scholarship program to help families who require assistance with these expenses. Generally, the Scholarship Fund will provide help with just a small portion of the registration fee and your family will pay the balance on an installment plan. Your placement on a Southside team will officially occur when the scholarship committee has reviewed and approved your application – WITHIN TWO WEEKS OF TRYOUTS, and you have signed the financial aid offer agreement. You will be required to cover additional player and team expenses which will include but are not limited to: travel, uniforms, equipment, and coach reimbursements. Your team may or may not offer fundraising opportunities to help offset costs. If they do not and you wish to pursue these opportunities, please contact the club office.
